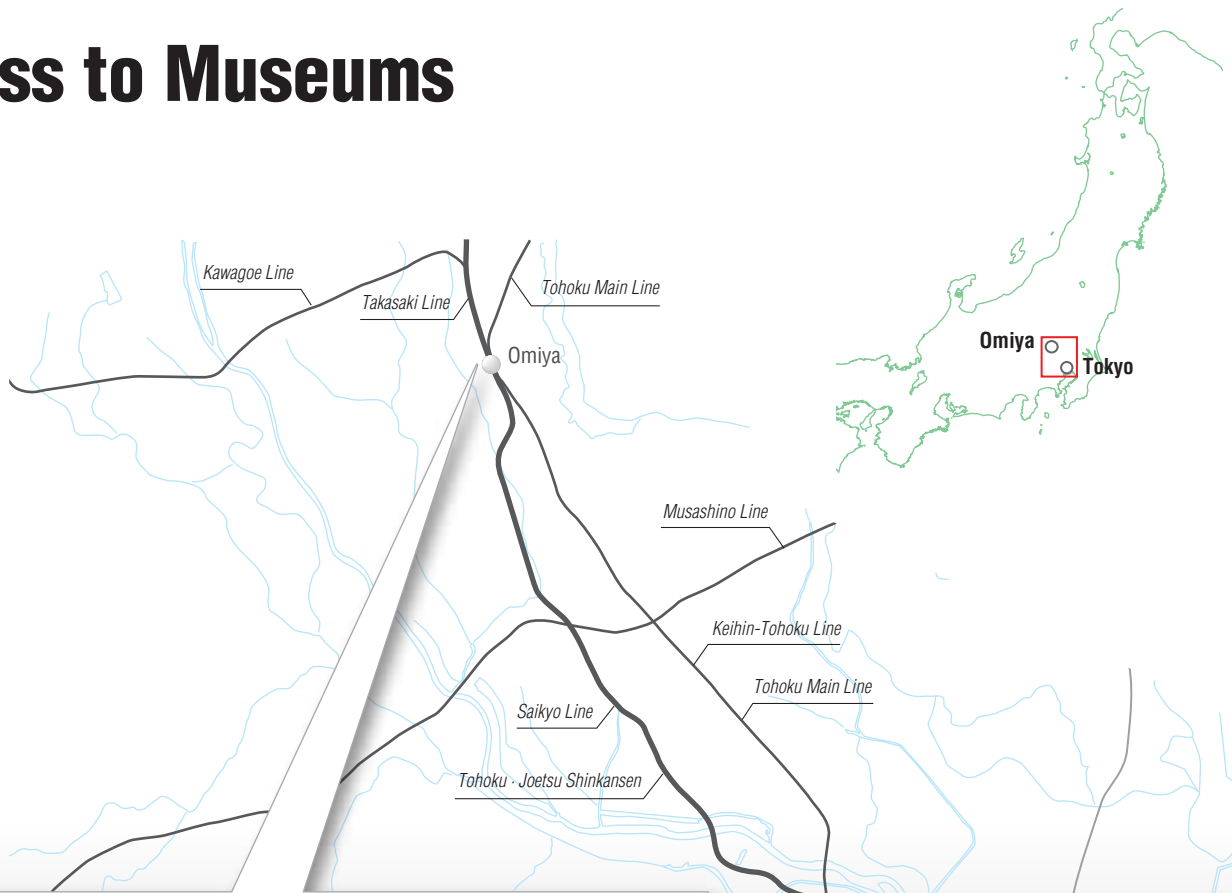

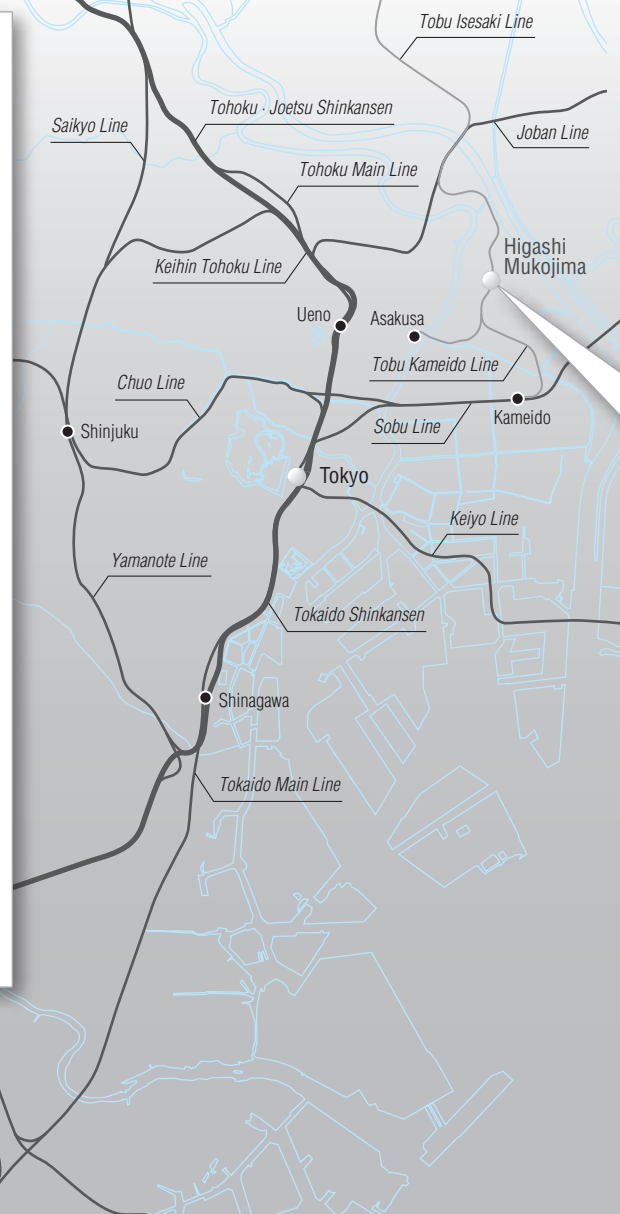

SCMAGLEV and Railway Park

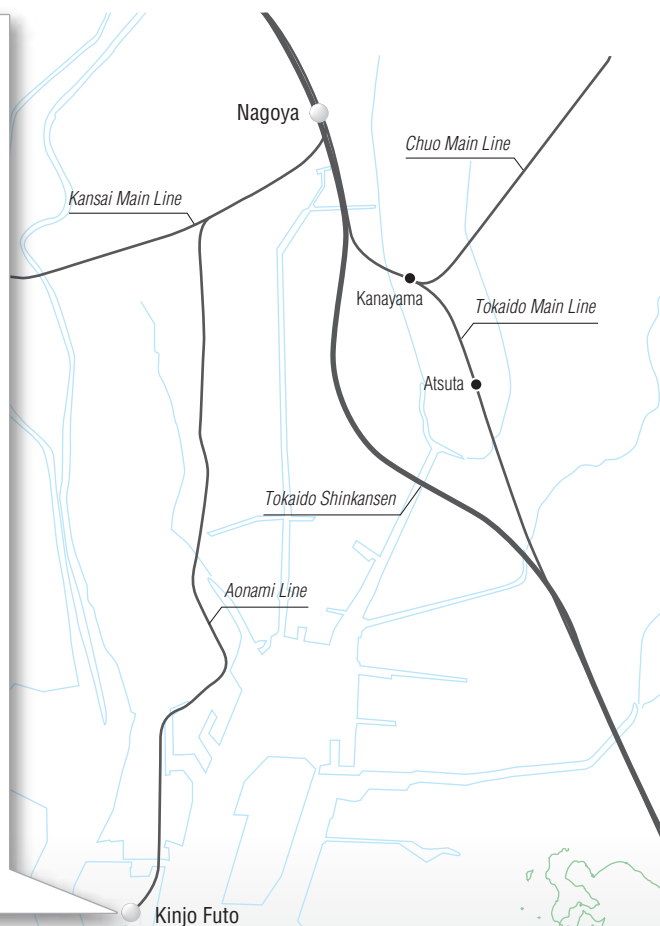
